He devoted many hours to making Grimesdale a clean, safe, and friendly place to live. He maintained the Grimesdale Community Park for 20 years and spearheaded numerous campaigns to improve and protect our neighborhood. His name is Rod Miller, and he passed away in March, only two months after Joan, his beloved wife and fellow community activist, died. These dynamic residents of Cheryl Drive were the heart and soul of Grimesdale. We were lucky to have them as our neighbors, and we will miss them greatly.
