**BOARD MEETING & TREASURER'S REPORT.** The April 2009 GHA Board Meeting was held at the home of Joyce and Chuck Mason. Our financial balance as of March 31 is \$4,906.67. (See Treasurer's Report on other side.) As of this writing, our membership for 2009 includes 62 homeowners.

**SUNSHINE REPORT.** On behalf of the Grimesdale community, Ruth Musolff, our Sunshine Director, sent a sympathy card to Chuck Mason of Mason Way, whose stepmother, Yoshiko (a former Grimesdale resident), passed away. Please keep Chuck and his family in your prayers and offer them a kind word if you see them.

A SIGN FOR ALL SEASONS. For many months the GHA Board has been considering various options for refurbishing the Grimesdale sign and the landscaping around it. The existing sign has deteriorated so much it cannot be salvaged. During the next few months, you will see John Mason of Mason Way working on the sign. John is a craftsman experienced in both housing construction and furniture making. He will remove the old sign and install a new one that will withstand the elements. If the existing lettering, which is also damaged, can be salvaged, the new sign will be similar to the old one. If not, you may see a new look (i.e., a new type style). The entrance to Grimesdale will also have new landscaping. GHA President Chuck Mason, his son, and GHA Treasurer Bill Fitch have already laid out a new bed border using retainer wall stones. This spring Chuck will plant evergreens, monkey grass, annuals, and perennials around the sign. If you see John, Chuck, Bill, or their helpers, please let them know you appreciate the work they're doing to beautify our neighborhood.

AN INTERNET INTERMISSION. If you've tried to access the Grimesdale website lately, you may have noticed that it's inaccessible. After Chris Swain, former GHA president and webmaster, moved from Grimesdale, we needed a new webmaster to replace him. GHA President Chuck Mason volunteered to serve in this position. Chuck's first priorities were administrative: to obtain full rights to the domain name (grimesdale.org) and to move the website to an economical service provider. Once these tasks are completed and the information is updated, the website will again be a valuable resource for Grimesdale residents.

**THANK GOD FOR SMALL PAVERS.** Some folks may have judged the recent road repairs to be unsightly and perhaps even unnecessary. Although this matter may be debatable, we think you'll agree that many of the repairs were urgently needed. If you've been reading your *Gazette,* you already know that the N.C. Dept. of Transportation had planned additional projects to improve the safety and drainage conditions along our streets. The DOT originally expected to complete these projects this spring. We've learned, however, that it may take up to two years for the DOT to finish its work in Grimesdale because of a lack of funding. Although our zebra-striped and leopard-spotted roads may look a bit wild, we should be grateful that our potholed pavement was tamed before the economy tanked and DOT funds evaporated.
