Like the witches, a few homeowners have been cooking up nasty brews in their own backyards. But instead of "eye of newt and toe of frog, wool of bat and tongue of dog," these homeowners have added even more deadly ingredients to their

cauldrons to "boil and bake": Styrofoam, rubber, cardboard, paper, plastic, lumber, shingles, paints, and garbage. It's illegal to burn any of these items. Offenders may be reported to the N.C. Division of Air Quality (296-4500) and could be fined up to \$25,000 or more. Please restrict your Halloween and autumnal brews to the benign (hot apple cider, for example) and help us to maintain a healthy atmosphere in our neighborhood.

**BEAR IN MIND.** Last year in mid-October, a mama bear and her two cubs wandered the streets of Grimesdale during the evening. This August another bear, probably a sow, was spotted one morning eating blackberries on Mason Way. Although acorns are plentiful this year, bears will also seek other easy meals, such as seed from bird feeders, as they prepare for hibernation.
