WILDLIFE FACES DEATH. Road kill is becoming more common on the streets of Grimesdale. The dead bodies of six white squirrels, two brown squirrels, and one opossum were discovered in one month alone. These poor critters, obviously the victims of hit-and-run accidents, didn't stand a chance because too many people drive at excessive speeds. **The speed limit on all Grimesdale streets is 25 mph.** Those casualties could well have been children or elderly folks strolling through the neighborhood. No appointment, errand, or to-do list is worth the life of another, whether it be animal or human. Please respect the speed limit and slow down when you see wildlife or human residents to prevent injury or even death.

PROWLER ON THE LOOSE. A resident of Magnolia Drive reported that a prowler had rummaged through two of her unlocked vehicles sometime during the late evening or early morning hours of May 27–28. Other residents of Magnolia Drive reported that, on the same night, someone rummaged through a backpack left on their front porch. They found the backpack's contents strewn over their front yard the next morning. Apparently nothing was taken in either case, but these episodes remind us that we should always lock our vehicles when they're parked outside and never leave anything valuable in an exposed or accessible area. We are a Community Watch neighborhood, which means that we watch out for our neighbors as well as ourselves. If you notice suspicious activity anywhere in Grimesdale, call the Sheriff's Office (697-4596 or 911 for emergencies).
