SO-SO SOCIAL. The ice cream social was held on Sunday, June 26 in the Grimesdale Community Park. Although the weather was beautiful, the ice cream was plentiful, and the mood was festive, the attendance was poor. Only 20 residents (all adults) came. Where were the children? This annual event is free, is open to all Grimesdale residents, and is intended to enhance community by offering a time and place to meet neighbors while sharing a tasty treat. Although those who attend the social always have a good time, it's disappointing that so few residents participate in this neighborhood get-together.

PICNIC IN THE PARK. Dining al fresco with family, friends, and neighbors is a summer pastime. The English word *picnic* is derived from the French term *pique-nique*, which was used in the 1600s to describe gatherings where gourmands brought their own wine. Before the Victorian Era, picnics were mostly held by the wealthy. In *Beeton's Book of Household Management*, published in 1861, Isabella Beeton listed these essential items for a picnic for 40 people: 1 roast and 1 boiled beef, 2 lamb ribs and 2 shoulders, 4 roast chickens, 2 roast ducks, 1 ham, 1 tongue, 4 meat pies, 6 lobsters, 1 calf's head, 18 heads of lettuce, 6 salad baskets,10 loaves of bread, 36 biscuits, 36 rolls, 6 pounds of butter, 48 pastries, 24 turnovers, 48 cheesecakes, 2 plum cakes, 2 pound cakes, 2 sponge cakes, 24 bottles each of ginger beer, soda water, and lemonade, 36 bottles of ale, 6 bottles of sherry, 6 bottles of claret, 2 bottles of brandy, wine, champagne, and other delicacies. The meaning of the term *picnic*, the bill of fare, and the nature of the participants have evolved since that time, thank goodness.

Our annual picnic will be held on **Saturday**, **August 6**, **from 12 to 2 p.m.** in the Grimesdale Community Park at the intersection of Cheryl and Charlyne Drives. If it rains that afternoon, the picnic will be postponed until the following Saturday, August 13, at the same time. GHA will supply the hot dogs, rolls, condiments, drinks, and eating utensils. Residents are asked to bring a side dish, salad, or dessert to share and perhaps lawn chairs for themselves. We hope more folks will attend the picnic than did the ice cream social. <u>All</u> Grimesdale residents are invited. Share your favorite recipes and sample those from your neighbors. Although we can't promise the treats that Mrs. Beeton offered at her picnics, we know that Grimesdale includes many talented chefs who, we hope, will grace us with their presence and their savory culinary creations.

The neighborhood garage sale will be held on **Saturday, August 20, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.** As in previous years, residents will sell their own goods in their own yards for their own benefit.
